2) All submissions must be in the MS Word (.docx /.doc) file format and a pdf file of the same must also be attached.

- Formatting of the write up:

For the main text– Times New Roman, Font size 12, Line Spacing-1.5

For the footnotes– Times New Roman, Font size 10, Line Spacing-1.0

Page Border – 1 inch on all sides

- Citation – All sources must be appropriately cited by using hyperlinks. Footnotes should be added wherever required as per the ILI citation style (<https://ili.ac.in/cstyle.pdf>).
- All submissions will be subjected to plagiarism check and those with a similarity above 15% will be rejected.

3) Co-authorship of maximum two authors is permitted. Both authors should be current students of Law Centre-II.

4) The policy brief is suggested to contain the following heads:

- Abstract
- Introduction of the Problem
- Explanation of the Solution
- Conclusion / Recommendation based on the Solution
- Bibliography

**General Guidelines:**

1. An abstract of 150 words has to be included at the beginning of the policy brief.
2. The argument in the policy brief should be based on evidence and backed by proper data.
3. The conclusions derived and the recommendations proposed should be generally applicable.
4. The policy brief should be concise. It should give the reader an insight into the problem.
5. Final score shall be based on following criteria:
  - Adherence to the word limit
  - Subject to plagiarism check
