#### Attention: All eligible Students seeking admission to LL.B. 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Year

All students of LL.B. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year, who have not been detained due to shortage of attendance, are being promoted **provisionally** to LL.B. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year respectively. All the provisionally promoted students are permitted to attend their LL.B. Classes as per BCI Rules.

- All the students of LL.B. 1<sup>st</sup> Year and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year, who have already passed 5 or 15 papers respectively and have not been detained in LL.B. II/IV Term, are eligible for admission to LL.B. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year for the Academic Year 2026-2027. (See Notification No. CNC-II/093/2014, Dated: 14 November 2014)
- Students are hereby advised to submit their Admission Form (available on the website of Law Centre-II) duly filled in all respects, in the office of Law Centre-II along with the following documents from 13.07.2026 to 24.07.2026 between 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. & 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. (Monday to Friday only)
  - Duly filled Admission Form.
  - Self-attested photocopies of all the "Statement of Marks".
  - Photocopy of ID Card issued by Law Centre-II.
  - Attach the copy of memorandum, issued by the Examination Branch, if any.
  - Undertaking, if required.

- Students who were detained to appear in their LL.B. III Term and V Term Examinations during the year 2025-2026 or before due to shortage of attendance, may also take re-admission in III Term and V Term respectively subject to the eligibilities.
- It may specifically be noted that those students who have not passed Paper No. "LB-501-Moot Court Exercise and Internship" in 5<sup>th</sup> semester, are required to take admission in 5<sup>th</sup> semester again along with the copy of relevant marksheet & Identity Card issued by Law Centre-II.

  - b) I shall not absent myself from any of the lectures without leave being obtained previously and that for sufficient cause; and if I am irregular in attendance, or fail to show progress, or am not diligent in my studies, my name may be struck off the rolls of the Centre without any reference or notice to me.
- 6.** That if I fail to produce the required certificates by the prescribed date, my name may be struck off from the rolls of the centre without any reference or notice to me.
- 7.** That on admission to the course of study for which I have made this application, I shall observe discipline, shall not commit any act of indiscipline, and submit myself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Professor-in-Charge of the Centre, the Dean of the Faculty of Law, the Vice-Chancellor, and the several other authorities and officers of the University who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Act, the Statutes, the Ordinances, and the rules that have been framed and will be framed from time to time by the University.
