



Dear students,

Please read this message very carefully.

The Placement Committee maintains a strict policy regarding interview attendance and internship acceptance:

If you are shortlisted for an interview through the Placement Committee, attend the interview, and are subsequently offered the internship or the placement, you must accept the offer.

Any student who rejects a secured internship offer or fails to show up (no-show) after being selected will be immediately blacklisted from the Placement Committee. You will lose all access to any future placement and internship opportunities driven through this cell. This will now be strictly enforced even against students of batch of 2026 who have failed to join after getting selected. They will not be allowed to avail any opportunities

Exceptions for emergencies: If you have an unavoidable, legitimate reason that prevents you from appearing or accepting, you must submit a formal explanation with specific reasons at least 10 days prior to the scheduled event/joining date. Last-minute excuses will not be entertained.

When you apply for a role, you commit to the process. Declining an offer or ghosting employers damages our institution's reputation and deprives your peers of opportunities. This has led to the college losing out on future opportunities and current students not getting opportunities due to students who waste the opportunity.

Please be mindful of your applications and only apply to companies you genuinely intend to work with.
