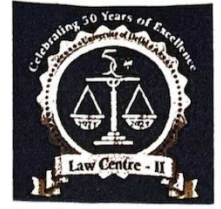

Meeting of Grievance Cell for LC:II Student Union Election 2025

The meeting of the grievance committee was held on 11th September 2025 in the office of Professor-In-Charge at 12.00 noon. The committee members, Dr. Ramakrishna Das PR, Dr. Archa Vashishtha, Dr. Ashish Kumar were also present.

The committee received three grievance applications from:

1. Mr. Pranav Mittal, Roll no 247616, 2nd year
2. Mr. Aditya Kumar Shukla, Roll 247055, 2nd year
3. Ms. Mansi Yadav, Roll 257470, 1st Year
4. Mr. Vidhi Raj, Roll No. 247939, 2nd year
5. Mr. Priyanshu Kumar, Roll No 232605, 3rd Year

The applications of Mr. Pranav Mittal, Mr. Aditya Kumar Shukla and Ms. Mansi Yadav have been rejected on the grounds of the absence of a witnesses on the surety bond. In this regard, the committee verified all three nominations and confirmed that there is no signature of witnesses on the surety bond submitted by all three candidates. All three members openly admitted during the hearing that it is a mistake on their side. It is a fact that the signature of these witnesses is an essential requirement for a surety bond, as well as the nomination, especially when the document is to be notarised. Hence, the applications of all three above-mentioned candidates are rejected.

The application filed by Mr. Vidhi Raj mentioned that he was not able to file the nomination due to some anti-social practices by the opposition groups. During the hearing, he stated that his application was snatched by a group of students on 10-09-2025 at about 03.00 pm. During the hearing, he came with a nomination, and we verified it physically and found that the application is still incomplete. In this view of the matter, the application is rejected.

The application filed by Mr. Priyanshu Kumar stated that his application was rejected since he is a student in his final year. In this regard, it has come to our notice that final year students are not allowed to contest for the post of Vice President by virtue of Rule 11(2) of the Constitution of Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU). In the absence of any provisions to the contrary in the Constitution of Law Centre:II Students' Union, the provisions of DUSU Constitution will be applicable *mutatis mutandis*. Hence, his application is also rejected.
