

## **NANI PALKHIVALA QUIZ ON CONSTITUTIONAL LAW,2023**

### **RULES**

The quiz on constitutional law is being organized with the objective of generating interest in study of the constitutional law amongst law students in India. The quiz will be designed to test not only the understanding of the Constitution of India as amended and its application but also the knowledge of the constitutional bench decisions of the Supreme Court of five judges or more decided till 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022.

#### **Organisation Of The Competition**

The competition will be conducted in two rounds; a preliminary round by way of written test (individual performance) and the final round in the shape of an oral quiz (team efforts).

The top six teams from the preliminary round will advance to the final round.

#### **Eligibility and Participation**

The competition is open to all students of 3 year and 5 year LLB courses in any law college recognized by the Bar Council of India.

Each law college in India can send maximum three teams consisting of two students each.

Registration and Participation amount of Rs.3000/- per team is to be paid by online mode in favour of Lex Consilium Foundations in current account No. 50200026075029 to HDFC Bank, opp Deer Park, New Delhi, IFSC Code HDFC0000503. Duly filled registration form with payment particulars of the team must be sent to Lex Consilium Foundations, House No.239, Sector 15-A,Noida-201301 latest by 30<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

Admit cards will be emailed to the participants after completion of the registration, by 10th January 2023.

Provisional registration will be completed on receipt of the scanned registration form and payment details. Registration will be completed on receipt of physical copies of the registration form with payment details.

Each student will carry the Institution identity card signed by the VC, Dean,Principal or Head of the Institution with his/her stamp. If the identity card issued carries signature of an authority other than the VC, Principal/ Head/Director then the participant must carry a separate authorization letter with photograph and signature attested of the students.

Candidates are to report to the allotted test center by 08:30 AM before the schedule commencement of the test for verification. Admit cards will be verified before the test. Parents, guardians or attendants etc, would not be allowed access to the premises

No candidate will be admitted 15 minutes after the commencement of the test.

The participants will be dressed in formals

### **Written Round**

Candidates are to be in possession of admit card, Identity proof writing materials: ball point pen, pencils, eraser and sharpener. Books, note book, calculators or mobile etc. are not permitted inside the test room.

Examination hall doors will be opened 30 minutes before the commencement of the test. The candidates are to be seated at the allotted place.

Participants must fill the necessary information in the space provided on the cover of the Question Booklet and the Answer Sheet before commencement of the test. Signature will be obtained in the attendance sheet during the test endorsing the Question Booklet No. as given on the Question Booklet and other details.

The candidate will be provided a sealed Question Booklet and an OMR Answer Sheet. The Question Booklet is not to be opened until announced.

The written test will be of 90 minutes duration and composed of 100 objective type questions consisting multiple choices, true or False and fill in the gaps, etc. It will cover the constitution of India. 15 questions will relate to Constitutional Bench decisions of the Supreme Court of five Judges or more decided till 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 .

All the questions and instructions of the test will be in English.

Rough work, if any, is to be done on the Question Booklet only. No separate sheet will be provided/used for rough work.

Each question shall carry two marks. There will be negative marking of one mark for every wrong answer. Extra time will not be granted for completing the test, on any grounds .

Non-adherence to any instruction or failure to comply with any rules governing the conduct of test will lead to disqualification. The Organizing Committee of the quiz competition shall serve as final arbiter of implementation and interpretation of these rules.

Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after the completion of test and when permitted by the invigilator.

The first three participants with the highest individual scores will be awarded individual prizes.

Each individual participant shall be assessed out of 200 marks in the preliminary round. The team score shall be calculated by adding the score of the individual participants. The merit list for individual participants will be calculated on the basis of higher individual score out of 200. In case of a tie, the individual with the higher score in the case law based questions (question no. 85-100) will be ranked higher. In case the tie still persists, the participant who is younger in age (as per the date of birth in the registration form) will be ranked higher.

The first six team with the highest teams scores shall advance to the final round.

The merit list for team scores for advancing to the final rounds shall be prepared according to the total scores obtained by each team by adding the scores of the individual participants in preliminary round out of 400. In case two teams have the same score, the tie shall be decided by the team having the highest individual participant score shall be ranked higher. In case the tie persists, the team having the higher score in the case law based questions (question no. 85-100) will be ranked higher. In case the tie still persists, the team having the youngest participant in age (as per the date of birth in the registration form) will be ranked higher.

### **Oral Round Procedure**

The first six team with the highest teams scores shall advance to the final oral round. In oral rounds total 24 questions will be asked. Time of maximum 45 seconds will be given to answer each question.

Each correct answer carries ten marks. Every incorrect answer would entail penalty of -five marks.

The merit list in the final round will be based on total score of team out of a maximum of 240 marks. The two teams with the highest marks in the final round will

be eligible for the team prizes. In case a tie in the final round, the team with fewer incorrect answers in the oral round will be ranked higher. In case the tie persists the team with the youngest participants will be ranked higher.

### **Prizes**

Each participant will get a certificate of participation.

The first three participants with the highest individual scores in the preliminary round will also be awarded certificates of merit and individual cash prizes. The three cash prizes will be of Rs thirty, twenty and ten thousands respectively. Medals will also be awarded.

The prizes for the first three teams will be of Rs.sixty, forty and twenty thousands respectively

The declaration of the preliminary round and the final round results will be declared and the prizes distributed at the valedictory function.

The prizes and participation certificates will be given during the valedictory ceremony . In case a participant or prizewinner is not present when his/her name is called out, his/her award and or certificate may be forfeited. Therefore participants are advised to remain present till the end of the competition and make their transportation arrangements accordingly.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

Participants will be expected to observe proper behaviour and conduct during all parts of the competition. Any participant engaged in any misconduct may be debarred from taking further part in the event.

Use of unfair means or any attempt to gain undue advantage will lead to immediate disqualification from taking further part in the competition and will be reported to the Head of the Institution of the student concerned.

Outstation students are expected to make their own arrangements for the accommodation and to /from travel.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to alter any Rule at their discretion.
